HISTORIC 18's RACE RESULTS

Race 13 of the 2020-21 Season and Heat 1 of the Australian Championship. Conditions were quite hot in the boat park with eight skiffs on hand for the day's racing. The race got underway from a scratch start off Kurraba Point in ideal sailing conditions on the no.2 East course.

Plenty of traffic on the harbour, with other events underway with the good weather enticing greater use of the waterway by all sorts of craft at this time of year.











After a not perfect start, Yendys led the fleet finishing over 5 mins ahead of The Mistake, followed by Australia IV, Scot, Top Weight, Tangalooma and Britannia. The adjusted times for the AHSSA Rating produced the same placings, while the handicap was also won by Yendys from Scot and The Mistake
