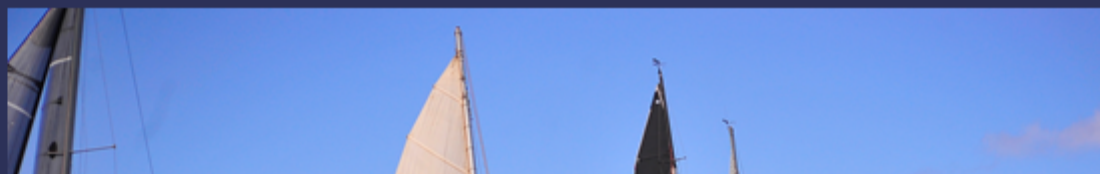

HISTORIC 18's RACE RESULTS

Race 19 of the 2020-21 Season and Race 3 of the Autumn Point Score.
The SFS Historic 18s race was recognised in the annual Sydney Harbour Regatta (SHR), conducted by the Middle Harbour Yacht Club.
It was a busy day on the harbour with the running of the SHR along with the first race of the annual J.J. Giltinan 18 Foot skiff championship.

Seven skiffs were on hand for the race. The race got underway from a handicap start off Robinson's Point on the no.3 SE course.
The four limit skiffs Aberdare, Britannia, Scot and Tangalooma got away to a well contested start, then Top Weight (14 min), Australia IV (6 min) and Yendys off scratch.













Scot was first across the line 1 min ahead of Top Weight and another 20 secs to Yendys (under ringtail), then Aberdare, Britannia and Tangalooma.

Australia IV was forced to retire when part of the structure on their bowsprit gave way.
